



BIOMETRIC SCREENING CHANGES

As we respond to COVID-19, you will notice changes in our biometric screening process. We are following guidelines and regulations from the CDC and OSHA in an effort to maximize safety for all participants and Health Coaches. Our focus is to ensure the same experience, but safer for everyone.

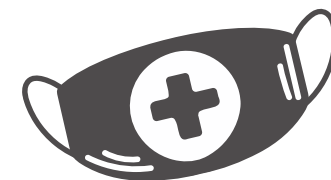
Temperature Checks

All Health Coaches are required to have their temperature checked prior to working any biometric screening event. Any Health Coach with a temperature above 100.4 degrees will be sent home and another team member will supplement.



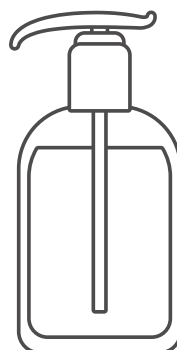
Personal Protective Equipment

Health Coaches are required to wear a sleeved cover coat, face mask, face shield, and gloves. Health Designs is requiring all participants to wear masks during the entire screening process.



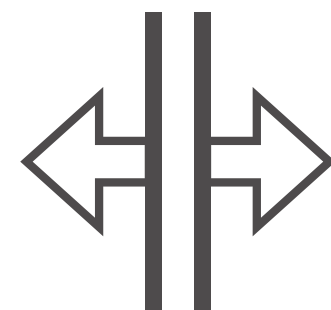
Increased Sanitation

Health Designs has developed sanitation protocol for all onsite events. Each station will be fully sanitized between every participant to ensure cleanliness. All wipes or spray are a minimum of 70% alcohol.



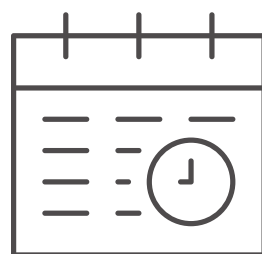
Social Distancing

Health Designs requires a minimum of 6 feet between all work stations. Proper social distancing is required through the entire span of the event.



Mandatory Appointments

All participants are now required to schedule an appointment for a biometric screening. Walk-ins will be provided instruction on how to make an appointment.



Limiting Touchpoints

Health Designs will be limiting the amount of touchpoints each participant could engage in during the biometric screening process.
