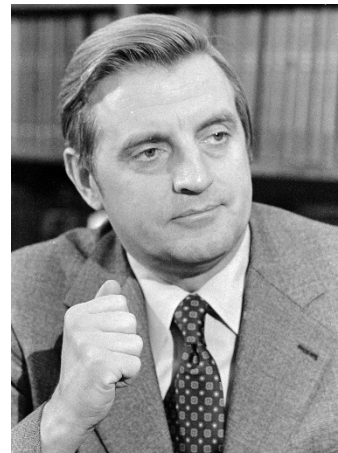

Did you know... Senator Brooke was the first African American popularly elected to the United States Senate? Senator Brooke was also an advocate of Voting Rights, Economic and Educational Equity, and anti-poverty programs.

Senator Mondale had a long history fighting for civil rights including supporting the Voting Rights Act of 1965, Desegregation, EEO laws, and he championed civil rights as Vice President under Jimmy Carter.
